Approximately \$1600 w/o the K of C. and approximately 100 Adults and 40 children attended. Final numbers pending. <p>New Business/General</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There was a short discussion on whether we should have a silent auction, with no direct association with a church event. - There was a good turnout for the Life Chain. Maybe 180 -200. - The K of C will get started on a St. Patrick's social event. They need to

coordinate with the Stewardship Committee (Cece is the chair person).

- There were about 40 signed up for the Men's Retreat at Estes Park.
- There was a general discussion about our new church, when can we start the capital campaign. Father said that he needs to work this with the Finance Committee.
- Father asked what the thoughts were on his homily this past week. Somebody thought he was a brave priest, others felt that the homily needs to be more balanced.
- Arleen mentioned an up and coming ladies event next week. It is a reconstruction of Ladies Night Out. Arleen had feedback that it was too social. The new event is titled "**Women's Time to Be**". There will be 5 events for the year. Next Thursday will be the first event. At the end of each event, the participants need to plan something for the community.
